Each team will work on ideas for 6-8 weeks under the supervision of chief mentor from TIE Hyderabad. Two teams from institution will be shortlisted through a business plan competition conducted at college level.They would then compete at state and national level of which 6 teams from India would be shortlisted for international challenge at Rice University USA.

TiE Grad 2019-20 Program Kicks off at SNIST



The new edition of TiE Grad program for the academic year 2019-20 was launched at the campus of Sreenidhi Institute of Science and Technology (SNIST), Hyderabad. On this occasion SNIST signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with TiE Hyderabad chapter to foster aspiring young entrepreneurs. TiE Grad program offers multiple advantages that includes – 1) Training and mentorship with dedicated Idea and business mentors who would regularly interact with SNIST’s students, 2) Interfacing SNIST with global entrepreneurs network, 3) Help build strong linkages with investors, and 4) Connect with domain experts. Speaking at the inaugural function Dr. P. Narasimha Reddy, Executive Director SNIST, welcomed the TiE delegate to SNIST campus and was highly appreciative about the association with TiE Hyderabad chapter. He advised students to gain in depth expertise and skill before venturing as a Startup. On behalf of SNIST management, He assured necessary support to students to build their idea prototypes and assistance with filing of IPR to protect their ideas. Bhanu Prakash, Director Graylogic Technologies-Core Committee member of TiE Hyderabad and Chairperson of TiE Grad Program, inspired students by sharing stories of successful entrepreneur’s journey including his own journey as a young entrepreneur. Bhat Dittakavi, Founder & CEO of Variance AI & Charter Member of TiE Hyderabad, has been nominated as the Business Coach to SNIST. Mr. Bhat gave an inspirational talk on why students should take up entrepreneurship, explained the important aspects with case studies examples. Chaitanya Kumar, Board Advisor Industry Arc and Idea Coach assigned to SNIST, trained the students on Business Lean Canvas. After the workshop Mr. Chaitanya validated students business ideas and guided them to improvise with refinement for effective presentation. The students for this workshop were shortlisted based on the Innovation Competition conducted earlier this month. Dr. Ameet Chavan, Dean SNIST

mentioned that students were highly motivated after the workshop and was certain of successful outcome this year.
