Minutes of the IQAC Meeting held on 17.07.2020 (Friday) at 3:00 p.m. in the Chambers of the Executive Director.

1. Review of the minutes of the meeting held on 14.12.2019.

The minutes of the meeting held on 14.12.2019 were reviewed and approved.

2. Discussion on teaching more number of IT related subjects to Non-IT students.

It is decided to offer Design and Analysis of Algorithm, Cyber Security, Artificial Intelligence etc. to Non-IT Students which will enhance the knowledge in the Computer related areas. The students can be placed in IT Sector with this knowledge.

3. Introducing Soft Skills in the curriculum at B.Tech. III Year level to benefit the students in placement.

All the members unanimously agreed to introduce Soft Skills in the curriculum for B.Tech. III Year Students to benefit them in their placements as the organizations are giving more importance to soft skills.

4. Organizing online teaching to the students during COVID -19, Pandemic time.

As per the decisions of UGC and JNTUH, it is decided to organize on-line classes to B.Tech, M.Tech & MBA Students and arrange best teachers to handle the classes as the teaching will be heard by parents and the Society. Maximum case is to be taken to see that the faculty members teaching the subject must prepare good PPTs and give notes whenever possible to acquire good knowledge and thorough understanding of the subjects.

5. Convening of MOCK BoS meetings at departmental level with the help of the faculty members for revising the syllabus of existing syllabus and introducing the new subjects.

"Design thinking as a stream" of Subjects can be introduced as it is very essential in the software organizations.

It is decided to reduce the credits for each branch of Engineering by eliminating obsolete subjects or combining the syllabus of two subjects by eliminating unnecessary portion of syllabus. and introducing latest subjects in the revised syllabus based on the AICTE guidelines.

Introducing group projects in B.Tech. III Year I & II Semester and IV Year I Semester, summer internships, training and presentation of technical seminars are to be strengthened so that student's improvements in theory and practical knowledge will be improved.

The students are to be encouraged to register for NPTEL MOOCS subjects and obtain appreciation from those organizations so that these subjects will enhance their capacity of thinking.

6. Convening BoS, Joint BoS and Academic Council meetings for approving B.Tech. III & IV Year Syllabus of A-18, regulations and B.Tech. I & II Year Syllabus of A-20 regulations.

The Syllabus of B.Tech. III & IV Year (A-18) regulations, B.Tech. I & II Years of (A-20) regulations has to be revised and reformed to suit the industries. The Principal, Dean (Academic), Chairman BoS are requested to convene the meetings. The revised syllabus and academic regulations are to be approved in the concerned BoS, Joint BoS and finally in Academic Council for the Academic Year 2020-21.

7. Organizing Faculty Development Programs (online) during COVI -19 period by inviting experts from outside so that the faculty members from our institution and other institutions will be benefited.

It is decided to organize number of FDPs in the latest filed. The faculty members are to be trained by inviting experts from the industries, R&D Organizations and leading education institutions, so that the faculty members can easily take classes with full confidence and students will feel happy in the fields, when new topics and new subjects are introduced.

8. Discussion on improving R&D, Consultation activities in the institution.

All the HoDs, Principal & Dean (Academic) are to encourage the faculty members to apply for Seed Money from the management and take up research work and publish papers. Based on the results obtained, they can apply for research grants from AICTE, DST, ISRO, UGC etc.

The knowledge gained through In-house projects and R&D projects sanctioned by various agencies will be helpful for consultancy works. In this process, the faculty members can publish papers and best results can be sent for patent also.

9. Discussion on establishing various Clubs and Committees to improve the leadership qualities of the students.

All the HoDs and Senior Faculty members have to encourage the students to participate in Literary Club, Sports and Games Club, Robotics Club, IC<sup>2</sup> Club, Adastra, Arts Club, NCC, NSS or Departmental Associations when the students take active part in such activities, they can perform well in the placements, as their written and communication skills, team building skills, life-long self-learning skills, problem solving skills are developed.

### 10. Encouraging the students to prepare and appear for certification programmes organized by Microsoft, Goggle etc.

As most of the jobs are in software sector, all the students irrespective of their core branch, they must have additional knowledge in the software area, and they must be encouraged to appear for Certification Programmes in the area of Computer Science and also in the area of their specialization to get good placements.

The students and their parents are to be informed about the Anti-ragging measures taken by the management in the buses, in the canteen and in the classrooms so that there will not be any ragging incidents during the last 25 years.
