

The result of this survey is based on the response of <u>874</u> students. The summary is displayed on the college website and it is also presented in the IQAC meeting.


SSS - RESULT & ANALYSIS








4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as 4- Excellent3 - Very god - Good1 - Fair0 - Poor












































