#### Minutes of Board of Studies meeting (EEE) held on 16-11-19.

I. B.Tech III year I semester, III year II semester, IV year I semester and IV year II semester course structure and detailed syllabus was discussed and approved with the following suggestions.

The suggestions are as follows:

- 1. PSO's are to be included in the mapping along with the PO's 'a' to 'k' in the each subject.
- 2. Avoid "Explain" term in outcomes and follow Bloom's taxonomy in defining CO's.
- 3. M&I Lab from IV year I semester to be brought to III year II semester.
- 4. Professional Electives (PE-1, PE-2 & PE-3) planned well but electives under Control systems are not planned well as DCS, ACS and MCS all brought in one semester. (i.e. in IV year I semester).

- 5. Pre-requites are to be completed before the Lab/Course comes in next semester.
- 6. Open Electives and service courses offered must be shown separately under a service course book branch-wise.
- 7. Efforts to be made to bring 'FMHM' theory and lab to II year instead of III year at least in the next revision of syllabus.
- 9. Better to have two sets of same experiments so that all students will do first five and then next five experiments, instead of the present practice of conducting all ten experiments at a time.
- 10. For Innovation and Design Thinking mapping matrix to be included.
- 11. For Switchgear and Protection, CO's need to be completely revised.
- II. Proposed syllabus for service courses offered by EEE Dept. to ECE, ME, CSE and IT were discussed and approved.
