Sub: Extension of AICTE approval to Sreenidhi Institute of Science & Technology, Hyderabad, Andhra Pradesh for B.S. Programme in collaboration with Vaughan College of Aeronautics and Technology, USA for the academic year 2008 – 2010 – Reg .

Sir,

This is with refrence to the application received from **Sreenidhi Institute of Science & Technology, Hyderabad, Andhra Pradesh** on the subject sited above. I am directed to convey the extension of approval of the Council to **Sreenidhi Institute of Science & Technology, Hyderabad, Andhra Pradesh** for conduct of the following courses in collaboration with Vaughan College of Aeronautics and Technology, USA with the intake indicated below:

It has however been notice that the institute has earlier failed to submit the Compliance Report with in stipulated time. The Sreenidhi Institute of Science & Technology, Hyderabad, Andhra Pradesh is here by warned to ensure submission of the compliance report and mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format along with enclosures at AICTE web- portal every year for Extension of Approval by the Council as per the prescribed date.

Non-submission/ incomplete submission of Compliance Report in future shall invite appropriate penal action against the institute and may be liable to following punitive action from any one or more of the following by the council: -

- i. **Suspension of approval for supernumerary seats.**
- ii. **No admission status in one/ more course.**
- iii. **Withdrawal of approval for programme/ course**
- iv. **Withdrawal of approval of institution.**

The above approval would be subjected to the fulfillment of the following general conditions:

1. That the management shall provide adequate funds for land and providing related infrastructural, instructional and other facilities as per norms and standards laid down by the Council from time to time and for meeting recurring expenditure.
2. (a) That the admission shall be made only after adequate infrastructures and all other facilities are provided as per norms and guidelines of the AICTE.
(b) That the admissions shall be made in accordance with the regulations notified by the Council from time to time.
(c) That the institute shall not allow closure of the Institution or discontinuation of the there course(s) or start any new course(s) or alter intake capacity of seats without the prior approval of the council.
(d) That no excess admissions shall be made by the Institutions over and above the approved intake under any circumstances. In case any excess admission is reported to the Council, appropriate penal action including withdrawal of approval shall be initiated against the institution.
(e) That the institutions shall not have any collaborative arrangements with any Indian and/ or Foreign Universities for conduct of technical courses other than those approved by AICTE without obtaining prior approval from AICTE. In case any violation is reported to the Council, appropriate penal action including withdrawal of approval shall be initiated against the Institution.
(f) That the Institution shall not allow conduct of any unapproved course whether technical or non-technical in the premises of AICTE approved institution/ campus and/ or in the name of Institution without prior permission from AICTE.
(g) The Institution shall not conduct any non – technical course(s) in the same premises / campus under any circumstances. In case any violation is reported to the Council, appropriate penal action including withdrawal of approval shall be initiated against the Institution.
3. That the Institution shall operate only from the approved location, and that the institution shall not open any off campus study centers/ extension centers directly or in collaboration with any other institution/ University organization for the purpose of imparting technical education without obtaining prior approval from the AICTE.

4. That the tuition and other fees shall be charged as prescribed by the Competent Authority within the overall criteria prescribed by the Council from time to time. No capitation fee shall be charged from the students/ guardians of students in any form.
5. That the accounts of the Institution shall be audited annually by a certified Chartered Accountant and shall be open for inspection by the Council or any body or person authorized by it.
6. That the Director/ Principal and the teaching and other staff shall be selected according to procedures, qualifications and experience prescribed by the Council for time to time.
7. (a) That the institution shall furnish requisite returns and reports as desired by AICTE in order to ensure proper maintenance of administrative and academic standards.

(b) That the technical institution shall publish an information booklet before commencement of the academic year giving details regarding the institution and courses/ programmes being conducted and details of infrastructural facilities including faculty etc. in the form of mandatory disclosure. The information booklet may be made available to the stakeholders of the technical education on cost basis. The mandatory disclosure information shall be housed in the website with updated information about all aspects of information.

(c) That it shall be mandatory for the technical institution to maintain a website providing the prescribed information. The website information must be continuously updated as and when changes take place.

(d) That a compliance report in the prescribed format along with mandatory disclosure on fulfillment of the above conditions, shall be submitted each year by the Institution within the time limit prescribed by the Council from time to time.

(e) That if Technical Institution fails to disclose the information or suppress and/or misrepresent the information, appropriate action could be initiated including withdrawal of AICTE approval.
8. That all the laboratories, workshops etc. shall be equipped as per the syllabi of the Foreign University and shall be in operational condition before making decisions.

9. That a library shall be established with adequate number of titles, books, journals (both Indian & Foreign) etc as per AICTE norms.
10. That a computer center with adequate number of terminals, Printers etc. shall be established as per AICTE norms.
11. AICTE may carry out random inspections round the year for verifying the status of the Institutions to ensure maintenance of norms and standards.
12. That the AICTE may also conduct inspections with or without notifying the dates to verify specific complaints of mis -representation, violation of norms and standards, malpractices.
13. That the Institutions by virtue of the approval given by Council shall not automatically become claimant to any grant- in-aid from the Central or State Government.
14. That in the event of a student/ candidate withdrawing before the starting of the course, the wait listed candidates should be given admission against the vacant seat. The entire fee collected from the student, after a deduction of the processing fee of not more than Rs. 1000/- (One thousand only) shall be refunded and returned by the Inspection/ University to the student/ candidate withdrawing from the programme. It would not be permissible for Institutions and Universities to retain the School/ Institution Leaving Certificates in original to force retention of admitted students (See Public Notice AICTE/ DPG/03(01)/2008).
15. The Institute shall take appropriate measures for prevention of ragging in any form, in the light of directions of Supreme Court of India in Writ petition No.(c) 656/1998. In case of failure to prevent the instances of ragging by the Institutions, the Council shall take appropriate action including withdrawal of approval.
16. That the Institute shall provide the following facilities for the physically challenged persons:
 - (a) Barrier free entry
 - (b) Class rooms, toilets and hostels to be made accessible to wheel Chair users.
 - (c) Resource room for visually impaired students.
 - (d) Accessible Library
 - (e) Counseling Centre for disabled students
 - (f) Facility of sign language interpreter

- (g) All students needing assistive devices to be provided such devices.
17. That the management shall strictly follow further conditions as may be specified by the Council from time to time.

In the event of non-compliance by the **Sreenidhi Institute of Science & Technology, Hyderabad, Andhra Pradesh** with regard to guidelines, norms and conditions, prescribed from time to time the Council shall be free to take considerations of any relations issues and that all liabilities arising out such withdrawal would solely that of **Sreenidhi Institute of Science & Technology, Hyderabad, Andhra Pradesh**.
