
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
TEACHING - LEARNING AND EVALUATION FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2022-2023


The result of this survey is based on the response of **1158** students. The summary is displayed on the college web-site and it is also presented in the IQAC meeting.















































































21. Give three observation / suggestions to improve the overall teaching – learning experience in your institution.
